Dear Council ,

Thankyou for your response regarding Changes Fitness Studio re location to the squash courts. I really appreciate your support enabling me to continue to deliver the services that Changes Fitness Studio provides to our community and surrounding districts.

After discussion with President Steve Carter on the 14th March and again today 19th March , confirming that I am able to book the second court for class environments, which are as follows;

Tuesday 5.30pm to 6.30pm
Wednesday 9am to 10am senior class
Wednesday 5.30pm to 6.30.....7 to 8pm
Thursday 5.30pm to 6.30.....7 to 8pm

Leaving court open for other bookings 4 days per week in the evenings and all day 7 days a week bar 1 hr on Wednesday's.

This timetable I will book in with front administration as regular bookings from Sept through to May..

We spoke about a few finer details that I'd like to be considered by council re the second court booking. I envisage that with a smaller space , class size may need to be modified , so I'd like to request that the use of the second court for the above class timetable be included in the \$300.00 inc

Per month that was approved from last meeting.

I would like to commence the re location from the 31st of March if this meets council approval.
