2024-2025 Rates Have Been Issued

The **2024/2025** rates were issued **Friday 26 July 2024**. Please contact Christie on 08 9661 0500 or rates@ dalwallinu.wa.gov.au if you have not received your notice.

Payment is to be received by the Shire of Dalwallinu prior to 4pm Friday 30 August 2024 to receive the 5% discount on the rates portion only if paying in full (discount already deducted from payment option 1).

If paying by the instalment option, the first payment is to be received by the Shire **prior to 4pm Friday 30 August 2024**. Instalment reminders will be issued via post 35 days prior to the due dates of

Second Instalment due Thursday 31 October 2024
Third Instalment due Tuesday 31 December 2024
Fourth Instalment due Tuesday 4 March 2025

Failure to make payment or contact the Shire by the due date may result in legal action been undertaken and the cost applied to your Rates Assessment.

Payment options are listed at the bottom of your Rates Notice. Please note if paying by electronic funds transfer our bank details have changed. For the new bank details please call the Shire Administration Office on 08 9661 0500. Bpay is our preferred online payment option.








Public Notice Aerial Kangaroo Surveys

The Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions (DBCA) will be undertaking an aerial survey for kangaroos and other wildlife from approximately 12th to 21st August 2024 (exact dates to be determined by weather conditions).

The survey consists of flights along pre-determined transect lines that are approximately 55 km apart and conducted at an altitude of 250 feet running east-west or west-east. Transects are flown once in a three-year survey period. The attached map provides an overview of the survey transects to be flown in 2024.



Electronic Forms available on Shire Website

The Shire would like to request that Ratepayers consider the electronic options they now have available for ease of receipt of all notices from the Shire. There are many options for you to consider when either contacting or receiving information from the Shire. Some shortcuts have links on the front page of the website.

We encourage all ratepayers to register for E-Rates now. This facility will ensure that you should never miss receiving your information even if you move house and forget to update your details with the Shire.

Change of Details /Address form

Use the Change of Details form to notify the Shire of a change of address, name or property details. It is important that the Shire has your correct details. Failure to do so may result in very important correspondence not getting to you e.g. your annual rate notice. Online Form – Registration for E-Rates now active

Council have established an E-Rates online registration form.

We encourage all ratepayers to enrol for E-Rates.

This will eliminate any loss or missing rates notices.

Benefits of E-Rates

- Quicker way to receive your annual rates notices (final notices and instalments are not available via eRates)
- Ease while travelling for a long time, on holiday or living overseas.
- You still get your notice if you have moved and forgot to update your postal address.

Things to be aware of before applying:

- If you are not the Owner or Agent for the Property, you are not eligible to register.
- There can only be ONE email address for each notice.
- If there is more than one owner of the property and other owner/s apply to receive an electronic notice, the eRates system will by default send the notice to the last registered email address.
- Once the registration is processed by the rates officer, you will receive a confirmation email.

Are you eligible for a Rates Concession?

If you hold one of the following concession cards, own and occupy a rated property within the Shire you may be eligible for a concession on your annual rates. Not applicable to properties used for commercial purposes including rural properties.

- Pensioner Concession Card
- State Concession Card
- Commonwealth Seniors Health Card together with a WA Seniors Card or
- WA Seniors Card

Registration is not done through the Shire of Dalwallinu but with the Water Corporation. To apply contact the Water Corporation on 1300 659 951 or complete the registration form available at http://www.watercorporation.com.au/Bill-and-account/Apply-for-a-concession

The Water Corporation will notify the Shire of Dalwallinu. Rates must be paid in full prior to 30 June of the rating year to receive the concession. Unsure if you already claim the concession? If you are already claiming the concession it will show as "State Government Rebate Allowed" on your Annual Rates Notice.

Department of Transport - Licensing Hours Monday to Friday from 8.30am to 4.00pm



The Shire of Dalwallinu offer licensing facilities on behalf of the Department of Transport. The licensing hours are set by the Department of Transport.

Please ensure you attend the offices early and allow adequate time for processing of your paperwork as the Department of Transport Licensing computers close at 4pm.

Shire staff do not have access after that time to Licensing computers.

Are you a Responsible Pet Owner?

The Cat laws are about encouraging responsible pet ownership and reducing the number of unwanted cats in the community and the number that are euthanised each year. All cats that have reached six months of age are required by law to be:

- micro-chipped
- · sterilised; and
- registered with the Shire

Under The Dog Act 1976 and regulations, any dog over the age of 3 months should be registered within the Shire. All dogs need to be micro-chipped. Proof of micro-chipping is required at time of registration.

Please be a responsible owner and secure your animals by registration. Legislation applies to Cats after six months of age and Dogs after 3 months. Registrations are due on 31 October each year.

Please don't risk losing your precious pets by not having them registered. Call into the Shire and make sure your animals are safe.


