Officers have commenced the 2025-2026 budget, so if you have any requests, please send them





Cyclone Seroja Local Government Resilience Fund

In 2023, the Shire of Dalwallinu was successful in receiving grant funding of \$500,000 from the Department of Fire & Emergency Services Cyclone Seroja Local Government Resilience Fund. The funds were utilised for the following:

- One 100kVa Generator for the Shire Administration Centre
- One 77kVa Generator for the Kalannie Sports Pavilion
- One 33kVa Portable Generator
- One 22 kVa Portable Generator

Emergency Accommodation

• New 2x1 Modular Home – rear of 68 Annetts Rd, Dalwallinu

The emergency accommodation allows the Shire to provide emergency accommodation to community members who lose their home through a natural disaster (flood, fire, cyclone etc). This accommodation is not for 'crisis' accommodation. Dalwallinu has an extreme housing shortage and without this accommodation we would have zero capacity to assist any community members in need of accommodation due to a natural disaster.

The Shire is extremely grateful to be provided with the funding and we believe we have utilised the funds to build resilience within our community.

The registration process is in two parts. The PART A online registration takes up to 10 minutes and the PART B Shire induction takes about 5 minutes.

We urge you to find 15 minutes of your time and complete these registrations to ensure you are compliant when attending fires. The registration also provides you with PPE. 


