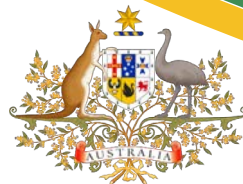

The two new modular houses have arrived at 68 Annetts Road, Dalwallinu. Construction of the carport, porch and alfresco areas is to be completed in the coming weeks. Unfortunately, we are still waiting for Western Power to reconnect power to the site and a date for this is unknown at this stage.

Uptake of the recently released residential lots on Strickland Drive, Dalwallinu has been slow. To date, two (2) lots are under offer. The industrial lots have moved faster

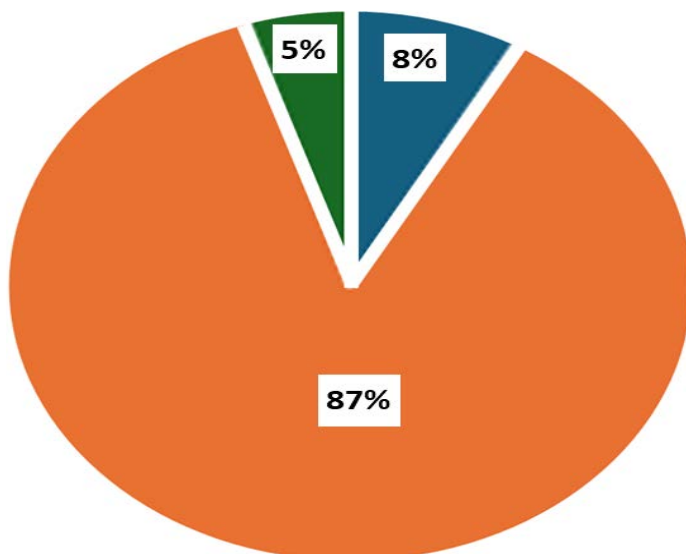
with only three (3) lots remaining. Further information can be found on our Facebook page or you can contact Brad King at Harcourts Nutrien on 0429 911 504.

Rain

There has been some nice rain for most of the shire which is great. We are still a long way below average but who knows what average is now.

I am mindful that areas north and east are very light on for rain and I hope a system comes through soon to assist these farms.

Roads

With the wet weather I will give my usual reminder to treat our shire roads with respect and avoid damaging the unsealed roads if possible.

The works crew keep our roads in very good condition and if we can help minimise their task we can focus more on other items in the shire than repairing damaged roads.

Because our roads are so good and vehicles are getting better there is a tendency for motorists to be driving

at higher speeds. Please slow down at crossroads and other dangerous points, and drive to stay alive.

Cr Dawson has raised this point at Council and I agree that many motorists are driving too fast with a *"it won't happen to me"* attitude.

The state road toll is at an alarming total and I feel more speed restrictions are going to be forced on drivers if we don't drive more cautiously.

Some of the stories of overtaking over double white lines are very scary and mean that we need to alert at all times while behind the wheel. We want all of our community getting home safe every trip.

Driving in the Rain

5 Tips for Staying in Control

With spring showers on the way, drivers can stay safer on the road by following a few useful tips.




1 Two on the Back




If you can only afford to replace two tires, replace the most worn tires and put the new ones on the rear. Whether you have a front-wheel, all-wheel or rear-wheel drive car, the back two tires are most critical for keeping the car going in a straight line to avoid fishtailing.

2 Feeling out of Touch?




Is the steering looser than normal? Are you sliding when you brake? If so, your tires could be losing their grip and you might be hydroplaning. Best to reduce your speed.

3 Losing Speed?




If you're pushing the accelerator and not going faster or slowing down while consistently holding the accelerator, you're likely losing traction. It's time to ease off the gas and resume a slower, safer speed.

4 Be Cautious from the Start



It doesn't have to be raining for long to compromise traction. When the first rain falls, the water can mix with oil and dust to create a slick surface. Slow down as soon as it begins to rain.

5 Seeing the Whole Picture



To properly inspect your tires for traction, turn the wheel so you can see the whole tire. The tread could be worn on the inside. If you just look at the side, you might not catch a trouble spot.

Fire Danger Ratings and Bushfire Warnings

-  **Moderate:** Plan and Prepare.
-  **High:** Be ready to act.
-  **Extreme:** Take action now to protect your life and property.
-  **Catastrophic:** For your survival, leave the bushfire risk areas.

Be Aware and Prepare



Where there is minimal risk, Fire Danger Ratings will be set to 'No Rating'. On these days you still need to remain alert and abide by local seasonal laws and regulations.

Emailing Rates Notices

You can elect to have your Rates Notice issued via email. This service currently does not extend to Instalment Reminders. To register for this option you need to be a ratepayer on the assessment and put your request in writing. You can apply online through the Shire website <https://www.dalwallinu.wa.gov.au/contact-us/erates-registration.aspx> or by completing a Change of Address form which can be obtained from the Administration office. If you own properties in multiple names a separate form is required for each individual/company. Notices can only be sent to one nominated email for each assessment and you will not receive a paper notice if this option is selected. You still need to keep your residential and postal addresses up to date.

Mailing Address not Correct?

It is your responsibility to advise the Shire in writing of any changes of address. Incorrect addresses may cause unnecessary delays in the delivery of your rates notice. Change of addresses must be made in writing by the ratepayer/s. An online form is available on the Shire website <https://www.dalwallinu.wa.gov.au/contact-us/change-of-details.aspx> or by contacting our Customer Services team.

Pensioner/Senior Rebate

If you are an eligible* pensioner or senior card holder who does not currently claim the rebate, you can apply through the Water Corporation, even if you are not a Water Corporation customer. The Shire are unable to receive applications direct from pensioners or seniors, applications must be made to Water Corporation.

To apply go online to <https://www.watercorporation.com.au/Bill-and-account/Apply-for-a-concession>. This is effective for both Local Government and Water rates. If you do not have access to the internet please bring your concession card to the Shire Office and we will help you apply for the concession. Unsure if you already claim the concession on your property within the Shire of Dalwallinu? If you are already claiming the concession you will have the line "State Government Rebate Allowed" on your Rates Notice. Your rates MUST be paid in full prior to 30 June 2026 to receive the rebate.

* To be eligible you must own and reside in the residential property for which you are claiming the rebate and hold the relevant concession cards.

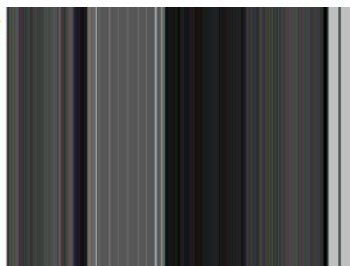
